Key Job Responsibilities

Primary responsibility will be:

- A good knowledge of playing field pitch maintenance is a must.
- To be able to determine when grass areas are in need of fertilising outside of scheduled maintenance.
- A very good standard of pitch marking is required.
- A very good knowledge of pitching lining (Cutting) is a requirement.
- Mow Grass either by hand or using a riding lawnmower.
- Cut lawn using hand, power or riding mower and trim and edge around walks, flower beds, and walls.
- Landscape by planting flowers, grass, shrubs, and bushes.
- Shovel snow from walkways and sprinkle ice when required.
- Power Blow / Sweep walkway of debris.
- Cut down tree limbs that are posing a danger with the use of a chainsaw.
- Trim shrubs and pull weeds.
- Perform minor repairs and maintenance procedures on equipment utilized in grounds keeping.
- Rake, mulch, and prune the grounds as needed
- Removal of waste, blowing, vacuuming and collection of grass and foliage clippings.
- It is the duty of the General operative to carry out daily checks of the facilities, and report any major defects to the Grounds Supervisor.
- Grass Cutting or Landscaping Duties as required in all weather conditions.
- Assist the Maintenance Team with Campus General Operative Tasks as required.
- Must have previous experience of landscaping, grass cutting, use of cutting and landscaping equipment, tractors etc.
